A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

by amending section 20912 (MCL 333.20912), as amended by 2000 PA 375.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 20912. (1) The department shall perform all of the 2 following with regard to educational programs and services:
 - (a) Review and approve education program sponsors, ongoing education program sponsors, and curricula for emergency medical
 - services personnel. PROGRAMS AND CURRICULA FOR PARAMEDICS OR
 - MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDERS MUST INCLUDE TRAINING IN TREATING DRUG
- 7 OVERDOSE PATIENTS THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO THE TRAINING PROVIDED IN
 - THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION BASIC LIFE SUPPORT COURSE FOR HEALTH

- 1 CARE PROVIDERS. Approved education programs and refresher programs
- 2 shall MUST be coordinated by a licensed emergency medical services
- 3 instructor-coordinator commensurate with level of licensure.
