## **HOUSE BILL No. 5551**

February 13, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Zemke, Pagan, Geiss, Green, Peterson, Cochran, Cambensy, Hertel, Gay-Dagnogo, Yancey and Greimel and referred to the Committee on Education Reform.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

by amending section 1321 (MCL 380.1321), as amended by 2016 PA 428.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1321. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 2 if a board of a school district provides transportation for its
- 3 resident pupils, other than students with a disability transported
- 4 under article 3 or other pupils who cannot safely walk to school,
- 5 the school board RECEIVES FUNDS UNDER THE STATE SCHOOL AID ACT OF
  - 1979, THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT shall provide transportation
- 7 to and from school for each resident public or nonpublic school
- 8 pupil if both of the following requirements are met:ENROLLED IN A
  - PUBLIC SCHOOL OPERATED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE

- 1 PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, IF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY RECEIVES FUNDS
- 2 UNDER THE STATE SCHOOL AID ACT OF 1979, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
- 3 THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM
- 4 SCHOOL FOR EACH PUPIL ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL OPERATED BY THE
- 5 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.
- 6 (a) The school district provides transportation for the
- 7 elementary school level, middle or junior high school level, or
- 8 high school level, as defined by the local school board, in which
- 9 the pupil is enrolled.
- 10 (b) The pupil attends either the public or the nearest state
- 11 approved nonpublic school in the school district to which the pupil
- 12 is eligible to be admitted.
- 13 (2) Transportation provided under subsection (1) shall be
- 14 without charge to the resident pupil, the parent, guardian, or
- 15 person standing in loco parentis to the pupil.
- 16 (3) A school district OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY is not required
- 17 to transport or pay for transportation of a resident pupil living
- 18 within 1-1/2 miles, by the nearest traveled route, to the public  $\frac{1}{2}$
- 19 state approved nonpublic school in which the pupil is enrolled. A
- 20 school district is not required to transport or pay for the
- 21 transportation of a resident pupil attending a nonpublic school who
- 22 lives in an area less than 1-1/2 miles from a public school in
- 23 which public school pupils are not transported, except that the
- 24 school district shall transport or pay for the transportation of
- 25 the resident pupil from the public school within the area to the
- 26 nonpublic school the pupil attends.
- 27 (4) A school district is not required to transport or pay for

- 1 the transportation of resident pupils to state approved nonpublic
- 2 schools located outside the district unless the school district
- 3 transports some of its resident pupils, other than students with a
- 4 disability under article 3, to public schools located outside the
- 5 district, in which case the school district shall transport or pay
- 6 for the transportation of resident pupils attending a state
- 7 approved nonpublic school at least to the distance of the public
- 8 schools located outside the district to which the district
- 9 transports resident pupils and in the same general direction.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
