HOUSE BILL No. 5646

February 27, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Calley and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

by amending section 5090 (MCL 168.5090), as added by 1994 PA 441.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5090. (1) The secretary of state shall direct and supervise the establishment and maintenance of a statewide qualified voter file. The secretary of state shall establish the technology to implement the qualified voter file on or before January 1, 1997. The qualified voter file shall be the official file for the conduct of all elections held in this state on or after January 1, 1998. The secretary of state may direct that all

- 26 28.291 TO 28.300, OF A DECEASED RESIDENT OF THIS STATE IS ALSO USED
- 27 AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH TO UPDATE THE QUALIFIED VOTER FILE TO CANCEL

- 9 OF THE CURRENT RESIDENCE AND VOTER REGISTRATION STATUS OF ELECTORS.
- 10 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY RECOGNIZED
- 11 MULTISTATE PROGRAM OR SERVICE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION THAT
- 12 REQUIRES THIS STATE TO PROMOTE OR ADOPT LEGISLATION AS A CONDITION
- 13 OF PARTICIPATION IN THAT PROGRAM OR SERVICE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 14 SHALL FOLLOW THE PROCEDURES UNDER SECTION 509AA(5) WITH REGARD TO
- 15 ANY ELECTORS AFFECTED BY INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH ANY
- 16 MULTISTATE PROGRAM OR SERVICE.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
