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HOUSE BILL No. 5715

March 13, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Moss, Elder, Sowerby, Chang, Lucido, Geiss, Hertel and Faris and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Trade.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 274, entitled

"Michigan antitrust reform act,"

by amending section 9 (MCL 445.779) and by adding section 3c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3C. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), DURING THE TIME PERIOD
- 2 OF A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY OR A LOCAL EMERGENCY, AND FOR 30
- 3 DAYS AFTER THAT TIME PERIOD, A PERSON THAT OWNS OR OPERATES A HOTEL
 - OR MOTEL SHALL NOT CHARGE A PRICE FOR LODGING THAT EXCEEDS THE
- 5 HIGHEST REGULAR ROOM RATE CHARGED BY THE HOTEL OR MOTEL IN THE 180-
 - DAY PERIOD PRECEDING THE DECLARATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY OR
 - LOCAL EMERGENCY.
- 8 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO A PRICE INCREASE BY A
- 9 PERSON THAT OWNS OR OPERATES A HOTEL OR MOTEL THAT IS OTHERWISE

- 18 THAN 180 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$25,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 19 (3) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY SHALL NOT
