- 3 ANY ALLEGATION RECEIVED BY THAT INDIVIDUAL THAT A HEALTH
- 4 PROFESSIONAL LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER ARTICLE 15 OF THE PUBLIC
- 5 HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16101 TO 333.18838, HAS COMMITTED
 - ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS:
- 7 (A) A VIOLATION OF SECTION 90 OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931
- 8 PA 328, MCL 750.90.
- 9 (B) A VIOLATION OF SECTION 145C OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE,
- 10 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.145C.
