HOUSE BILL No. 5912

May 1, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Zemke, Geiss, Camilleri and LaGrand and referred to the Committee on Education Reform.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1283.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1283. (1) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 2 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY THAT CONTRACTS FOR INTEGRATED
- 3 STUDENT SUPPORTS IS ENCOURAGED TO ENSURE THAT ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 4 ARE MET:
- 5 (A) THE INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS ARE PROVIDED TO PUPILS AND
- 6 THEIR FAMILIES BY AN EXTERNAL COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION THAT
- 7 ACTS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 8 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY. THE INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS
- 9 SHALL BE MUTUALLY AGREED UPON BY THE BUILDING LEVEL STAFF AND THE
- 10 COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION, WHICH SHALL WORK IN CONJUNCTION WITH SCHOOL
- 11 SUPPORT STAFF TO DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

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- 1 (i) IMPROVE THE COORDINATION, AVAILABILITY, DELIVERY, AND
- 2 EFFECTIVENESS OF INTEGRATED SUPPORTS AND COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORTS FOR
- 3 PUPILS AND FAMILIES, INCLUDING ENHANCING LEARNING OUTCOMES FOR
- 4 PUPILS.
- 5 (ii) ACT AS A LIAISON WITH OTHER ORGANIZATIONS IN ORDER TO
- 6 ASSIST SCHOOLS IN PROVIDING PUPILS AND FAMILIES THE INTEGRATED
- 7 SUPPORTS AND COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORTS NEEDED TO IMPROVE THE LEARNING
- 8 OF PUPILS AND THEIR ABILITY TO PLAN FOR POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL
- 9 AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, HEALTH
- 10 SERVICES, EMPLOYMENT SERVICES, MENTORING OR TUTORING SERVICES,
- 11 HUMAN SERVICES, ENRICHMENT AND ACCELERATED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES,
- 12 BEFORE- AND AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS, AND RECREATION, AND RELATED
- 13 ASSISTANCE.
- 14 (iii) IMPROVE COMMUNICATION AND COORDINATION BETWEEN A SCHOOL
- 15 AND THE PUPILS AND FAMILIES THE SCHOOL SERVES.
- 16 (B) THE INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS ARE PROVIDED TO PUPILS AND
- 17 THEIR FAMILIES BY AN ORGANIZATION THAT INCLUDES COMMUNITY SCHOOL
- 18 STRATEGIES AND THAT UTILIZES AN EXTERNAL INDEPENDENTLY EVALUATED
- 19 EVIDENCE-BASED MODEL OF INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS THAT IS PROVEN
- 20 TO INCREASE PUPIL ACHIEVEMENT.
- 21 (C) THE INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS SHALL SUPPLEMENT RATHER
- 22 THAN DUPLICATE THE SUPPORTS ALREADY PROVIDED BY THE SCHOOL
- 23 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY
- 24 AND SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 25 (i) AN ASSESSMENT OF PUPIL AND FAMILY NEEDS IN SCHOOLS.
- 26 (ii) PLACEMENT OF SITE-BASED STAFF IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL

27 BUILDING.

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- 1 (iii) ENHANCEMENT OF THE SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL, INTELLECTUAL, AND
- 2 PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF PUPILS.
- 3 (iv) PROVISION OF TRAINING RELATED TO INTEGRATED STUDENT
- 4 SUPPORTS TO STAFF, TEACHERS, AND, AS APPROPRIATE, PARENTS AND
- 5 COMMUNITY LEADERS.
- 6 (v) LINKAGE OF NECESSARY SERVICES AND COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORTS
- 7 TO PUPILS, THEIR FAMILIES, AND THEIR PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
- 8 (vi) ASSESSMENT OF THESE SERVICES AND SUPPORTS THROUGH AN
- 9 EVALUATED MODEL THAT IS PROVEN TO INCREASE PUPIL ACHIEVEMENT.
- 10 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 11 (A) "COMMUNITY SCHOOL STRATEGIES" MEANS TACTICS THAT INCLUDE
- 12 DEVELOPING A SET OF PARTNERSHIPS BETWEEN A SCHOOL AND OTHER
- 13 COMMUNITY RESOURCES, WITH AN INTEGRATED FOCUS ON ACADEMICS, HEALTH
- 14 AND SOCIAL SERVICES, YOUTH AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, AND COMMUNITY
- 15 ENGAGEMENT WITH THE GOALS OF IMPROVING STUDENT LEARNING, AND
- 16 DEVELOPING STRONGER COMMUNITIES AND A POSITIVE SCHOOL CLIMATE.
- 17 (B) "EXTERNAL COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN ENTITY
- 18 COMPRISED OF LOCAL STAKEHOLDERS INCLUDING INDIVIDUALS, GROUPS,
- 19 BUSINESSES, AND INSTITUTIONS THAT SHARE THE GOAL OF IMPROVING
- 20 STUDENT LEARNING THROUGH AN INTEGRATED FOCUS ON ACADEMICS, HEALTH
- 21 AND SOCIAL SERVICES, YOUTH AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, AND COMMUNITY
- 22 ENGAGEMENT.
- 23 (C) "INTEGRATED STUDENT SUPPORTS" MEANS A SYSTEM OF WRAPAROUND
- 24 SERVICES FOR STUDENTS DESIGNED TO PROMOTE ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT
- 25 THROUGH TARGETING BOTH ACADEMIC AND NONACADEMIC BARRIERS TO
- 26 LEARNING.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
