THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

2 organization, other than a law enforcement agency of this state or 3 a political subdivision of this state, shall not, in connection with an application for employment or membership —or in connection with the terms, conditions, or privileges of employment or 5 membership, request, make, or maintain a record of information 7 regarding a misdemeanor OR FELONY arrest - OR detention, or THE disposition OF A MISDEMEANOR, where IF a conviction did not result. 8 A person is not guilty of perjury or otherwise for OTHERWISE giving 10 a false statement by failing to recite or acknowledge information 11 the person has a civil right to withhold by UNDER this section.
