- 5 MOTION OF ANY PARTY, AN ADVOCATE TO REPRESENT THE INTERESTS OF THE

- 16 (C) "LAW SCHOOL" MEANS A LAW SCHOOL ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN
- 17 BAR ASSOCIATION LOCATED IN THIS STATE.
- 18 (D) "INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION" MEANS A COLLEGE,
