A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 43536a (MCL 324.43536a), as amended by 2014 PA
281.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 43536a. (1) Beginning March 1, 2014, an AN active member of the military may obtain any license under this part for which a lottery is not required at no cost upon presentation to a licensing agent of leave papers, duty papers, military orders, or other evidence acceptable to the department verifying that he or she is stationed outside of this state. The license is valid during the season in which that license would otherwise be valid.
