HOUSE BILL No. 6069

May 24, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Lucido and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

by amending section 12601 (MCL 333.12601), as amended by 2009 PA 188.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 12601. (1) As used in this part:

- (a) "Casino" means that term as defined in section 2 of the Michigan gaming control and revenue act, 1996 IL 1, MCL 432.202. Casino does not include a casino operated under the Indian gaming regulatory act, 25 USC 2701 to 2721.
- (b) "Child caring institution" and "child care center" mean those terms as defined in section 1 of 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111.
 - (c) "Cigar" means any roll of tobacco weighing 3 or more

- 1 pounds per 1,000, which roll has a wrapper or cover consisting only
- 2 of tobacco.
- 3 (d) "Cigar bar" means an establishment or area within an
- 4 establishment that is open to the public and is designated for the
- 5 smoking of cigars, purchased on the premises or elsewhere.
- 6 (e) "County medical care facility" means that term as defined
- 7 in section 20104.
- 8 (f) "Educational facility" means a building owned, leased, or
- 9 under the control of a public or private school system, college, or
- 10 university.
- 11 (g) "Food service establishment" means a food service
- 12 establishment as defined in section 12905.
- (h) "Health facility" means a health facility or agency
- 14 licensed under article 17, except a home for the aged, nursing
- 15 home, county medical care facility, hospice, or hospital long-term
- 16 care unit.
- 17 (i) "Home for the aged" means that term as defined in section
- **18** 20106.
- 19 (j) "Hospice" means that term as defined in section 20106.
- 20 (k) "Hospital long-term care unit" means that term as defined
- 21 in section 20106.
- 22 (l) "Meeting" means a meeting as defined in section 2 of the
- 23 open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.262.
- 24 (m) "Motor vehicle" means that term as defined in section 33
- of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.33.
- 26 (n) "Nursing home" means that term as defined in section
- **27** 20109.

- 1 (o) "Place of employment" means an enclosed indoor area that
- 2 contains 1 or more work areas for 1 or more persons employed by a
- 3 public or private employer. Place of employment does not include
- 4 any of the following:
- 5 (i) A structure used primarily as the residence of the owner
- 6 or lessee that is also used as an office for the owner or lessee
- 7 and for no other employees.
- 8 (ii) A food service establishment that is subject to section
- **9** 12905.
- 10 (iii) A motor vehicle.
- 11 (p) "Public body" means a public body as defined in section 2
- 12 of the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.262.
- 13 (q) "Public place" , except as otherwise provided in
- 14 subsection (2), means any of the following:
- 15 (i) An enclosed, indoor area owned or operated by a state or
- 16 local governmental agency and used by the general public or serving
- 17 as a meeting place for a public body, including an office,
- 18 educational facility, home for the aged, nursing home, county
- 19 medical care facility, hospice, hospital long-term care unit,
- 20 auditorium, arena, meeting room, or public conveyance.
- (ii) An enclosed, indoor area that is not owned or operated by
- 22 a state or local governmental agency, is used by the general
- 23 public, and is any of the following:
- 24 (A) An educational facility.
- 25 (B) A home for the aged, nursing home, county medical care
- 26 facility, hospice, or hospital long-term care unit.
- 27 (C) An auditorium.

- 1 (D) An arena.
- 2 (E) A theater.
- 3 (F) A museum.
- 4 (G) A concert hall.
- 5 (H) Any other facility during the period of its use for a
- 6 performance or exhibit of the arts.
- 7 (iii) A STATE PARK.
- 8 (iv) A BATHING BEACH OR BUOYED BATHING OR SWIMMING AREA, THAT
- 9 IS OWNED, OPERATED, OR MAINTAINED FOR PUBLIC USE BY THIS STATE.
- 10 (v) A PLAYGROUND AREA THAT IS OWNED, OPERATED, OR MAINTAINED
- 11 FOR PUBLIC USE BY THIS STATE.
- 12 (vi) (vi) Unless otherwise exempt under this part, a place of
- **13** employment.
- 14 (r) "Smoking" or "smoke" means the burning of a lighted cigar,
- 15 cigarette, pipe, or any other matter or substance that contains a
- 16 tobacco product OR THE USE OF A VAPOR PRODUCT.
- 17 (s) "Smoking paraphernalia" means any equipment, apparatus, or
- 18 furnishing that is used in or necessary for the activity of
- 19 smoking.
- 20 (T) "STATE PARK" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 74301
- 21 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA
- 22 451, MCL 324.74301.
- 23 (U) (t) "Tobacco product" means a product that contains
- 24 tobacco and is intended for human consumption, including, but not
- 25 limited to, cigarettes, noncigarette smoking tobacco, or smokeless
- 26 tobacco, as those terms are defined in section 2 of the tobacco
- 27 products tax act, 1993 PA 327, MCL 205.422, and cigars. **TOBACCO**

- 1 PRODUCT DOES NOT INCLUDE A VAPOR PRODUCT.
- 2 (V) (u) "Tobacco specialty retail store" means an
- 3 establishment in which the primary purpose is the retail sale of
- 4 tobacco products and smoking paraphernalia, and in which the sale
- 5 of other products is incidental. Tobacco specialty retail store
- 6 does not include a tobacco department or section of a larger
- 7 commercial establishment or any establishment with any type of
- 8 liquor, food, or restaurant license.
- 9 (W) "VAPOR PRODUCT" MEANS A NONCOMBUSTIBLE PRODUCT CONTAINING
- 10 NICOTINE THAT EMPLOYS A HEATING ELEMENT, POWER SOURCE, ELECTRONIC
- 11 CIRCUIT, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC, CHEMICAL, OR MECHANICAL MEANS,
- 12 REGARDLESS OF SHAPE OR SIZE, THAT CAN BE USED TO PRODUCE VAPOR FROM
- 13 NICOTINE IN A SOLUTION OR OTHER FORM. VAPOR PRODUCT INCLUDES AN
- 14 ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE, ELECTRONIC CIGAR, ELECTRONIC CIGARILLO,
- 15 ELECTRONIC PIPE, OR SIMILAR PRODUCT OR DEVICE AND A VAPOR CARTRIDGE
- 16 OR OTHER CONTAINER OF NICOTINE IN A SOLUTION OR OTHER FORM THAT IS
- 17 INTENDED TO BE USED WITH OR IN AN ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE, ELECTRONIC
- 18 CIGAR, ELECTRONIC CIGARILLO, ELECTRONIC PIPE, OR SIMILAR PRODUCT OR
- 19 DEVICE. VAPOR PRODUCT DOES NOT INCLUDE A PRODUCT REGULATED AS A
- 20 DRUG OR DEVICE BY THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION
- 21 UNDER SUBCHAPTER V OF THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT, 21
- 22 USC 351 TO 360FFF-7.
- 23 (X) (v) "Work area" means a site within a place of employment
- 24 at which 1 or more employees perform services for an employer.
- 25 (2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and
- 26 principles of construction applicable to all articles of this code.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.
