A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act,"

(MCL 205.91 to 205.111) by adding section 4ff.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 4FF. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2019, A PERSON SUBJECT TO
- 2 THE TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE FROM THE PURCHASE PRICE USED FOR
- 3 THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX ON THE STORAGE, USE, OR CONSUMPTION OF A
- 4 NEW ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLE OR A MOTOR VEHICLE POWERED BY MOTOR
- 5 FUEL THAT HAS BEEN CONVERTED TO AN ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLE THE
- 6 FOLLOWING AMOUNT DETERMINED BASED ON THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE OF
- 7 EMPTY WEIGHTS OF THE ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLE:
 - (A) UP TO 6,000 POUNDS, \$1,000.00.

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- 1 (B) 6,001 TO 16,000 POUNDS, \$2,500.00.
- 2 (C) 16,001 TO 26,000 POUNDS, \$5,000.00.
- 3 (D) OVER 26,000 POUNDS, \$7,500.00.
- 4 (2) THE EXCLUSION ALLOWED UNDER THIS SECTION ALSO APPLIES TO A
- 5 NEW ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLE PURCHASED FOR LEASE IF THE TERM OF
- 6 THE LEASE IS AT LEAST 2 YEARS.
- 7 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 8 (A) "ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE
- 9 MANUFACTURED BY AN ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER THAT FULLY
- 10 WARRANTS AND CERTIFIES THAT THE MOTOR VEHICLE MEETS FEDERAL MOTOR
- 11 VEHICLE SAFETY STANDARDS FOR ITS CLASS OF VEHICLES AS DEFINED BY
- 12 THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO 257.923, AND
- 13 CERTIFIES THAT THE MOTOR VEHICLE MEETS LOCAL EMISSIONS STANDARDS,
- 14 THAT IS PROPELLED BY AN ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SYSTEM. ALTERNATIVE
- 15 ENERGY VEHICLE INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (i) AN ALTERNATIVE FUELED VEHICLE. AS USED IN THIS
- 17 SUBPARAGRAPH, "ALTERNATIVE FUELED VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE
- 18 THAT CAN ONLY BE POWERED BY A CLEAN FUEL ENERGY SYSTEM AND CAN ONLY
- 19 BE FUELED BY A CLEAN FUEL.
- 20 (ii) A FUEL CELL VEHICLE. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, "FUEL
- 21 CELL VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE POWERED SOLELY BY A FUEL CELL
- 22 ENERGY SYSTEM.
- 23 (iii) AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH,
- 24 "ELECTRIC VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE POWERED SOLELY BY A
- 25 BATTERY CELL ENERGY SYSTEM.
- 26 (iv) A HYBRID VEHICLE. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, "HYBRID
- 27 VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT CAN ONLY BE POWERED BY AN

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- 1 INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE AND 1 OR MORE ALTERNATIVE ENERGY
- 2 SYSTEMS.
- 3 (v) A SOLAR VEHICLE. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, "SOLAR
- 4 VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE POWERED SOLELY BY A PHOTOVOLTAIC
- 5 ENERGY SYSTEM.
- 6 (vi) A HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLE. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH,
- 7 "HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE POWERED BY AN
- 8 INTEGRATED PROPULSION SYSTEM CONSISTING OF AN ELECTRIC MOTOR AND
- 9 COMBUSTION ENGINE. HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLE DOES NOT INCLUDE A
- 10 RETROFITTED CONVENTIONAL DIESEL OR GASOLINE ENGINE. A HYBRID
- 11 ELECTRIC VEHICLE OBTAINS THE POWER NECESSARY TO PROPEL THE MOTOR
- 12 VEHICLE FROM A COMBUSTION ENGINE AND 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (A) A BATTERY CELL ENERGY SYSTEM.
- 14 (B) A FUEL CELL ENERGY SYSTEM.
- 15 (C) A PHOTOVOLTAIC ENERGY SYSTEM.
- 16 (B) "MOTOR FUEL" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 3 OF
- 17 THE STREAMLINED SALES AND USE TAX REVENUE EQUALIZATION ACT, 2004 PA
- 18 175, MCL 205.173.
- 19 (C) "NEW ALTERNATIVE ENERGY VEHICLE" MEANS AN ALTERNATIVE
- 20 ENERGY VEHICLE WHICH IS NOT AND HAS NOT BEEN A DEMONSTRATOR,
- 21 EXECUTIVE OR MANUFACTURER'S VEHICLE, LEASED VEHICLE, OR A USED OR
- 22 SECONDHAND VEHICLE.
