HOUSE BILL No. 6086

May 29, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Vaupel, Howrylak, Brann, Cochran, Hughes, Noble and Lucido and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 905a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 905A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON
- 2 LICENSED UNDER THIS ACT TO SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON
- 3 OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES AT RETAIL SHALL POST IN A CONSPICUOUS
- 4 LOCATION A SIGN INFORMING THE PUBLIC OF THE EFFECTS OF ALCOHOL
- 5 CONSUMPTION DURING PREGNANCY. THE SIGN SHALL CONTAIN THE MESSAGE:
- 6 "PREGNANCY AND ALCOHOL DO NOT MIX. DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES,
- 7 INCLUDING WINE, COOLERS, AND BEER, DURING PREGNANCY CAN CAUSE BIRTH
- 8 DEFECTS.". THE COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP AND FURNISH THE SIGN.
 - (2) IF THE PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SELLS ALCOHOLIC

- 1 LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES, INSTEAD OF POSTING
- 2 A SIGN THE PERSON MAY PLACE THE MESSAGE REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (1)
- 3 ON A MENU.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
