A bill to amend 1978 PA 485, entitled

"An act to permit the creation of a county officers compensation commission; to prescribe the powers and duties of the commission and other public officers; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 45.473).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. (1) The SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), THE county officers compensation commission shall determine the compensation of the elected officials of the county, other than judges. , which THE determination shall be IS the compensation of those officials unless the county board of commissioners rejects the determination by resolution adopted by 2/3 of the members elected to and serving on the board. Unless rejected, the determination shall be IS

- 1 effective at the beginning of the first odd numbered year after the
- 2 determination is made. If the determination is rejected, the
- 3 compensation then in effect when the determination is rejected
- 4 REMAINS IN EFFECT for those officials. shall continue. An expense

- 6 THAT IS in addition to HIS OR HER salary shall be for expenses
- 7 incurred in the course of county business and accounted for to the
