## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 19a. (1) If the state or federal government A PERSON THAT
- 2 USED OR THAT is or was the owner or operator of RESPONSIBLE FOR THE
- 3 USE OF A SUBSTANCE OF CONCERN ON real property at the time a
- 4 substance of concern was used on the real property, the state or
- 5 federal government OWNED OR OPERATED BY THAT PERSON shall provide
- 6 an alternative water supply to the users of an impacted water
  - source in the vicinity of the real property if all of the following
- 8 conditions are met:

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- (a) The Michigan department of health and human services has
- issued a public health advisory for drinking water covering the

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- 1 geographic area in the vicinity of the real property.
- 2 (b) The substance of concern that is the subject of the public
