A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

(MCL 339.101 to 339.2677) by adding section 1212.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1212. (1) BEGINNING 180 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 2 THIS SECTION, AS A CONDITION FOR THE RENEWAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S
- 3 LICENSE AS A SERVICE PROVIDER UNDER THIS ARTICLE, THE INDIVIDUAL
- MUST COMPLETE 1 HOUR OF CONTINUING EDUCATION ABOUT RECOGNIZING
- INDICATORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, AND HUMAN
- 6 TRAFFICKING OFFERED BY A CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDER APPROVED OR
  - RECOGNIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION 207.
    - (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS APPLYING FOR THE RENEWAL OF A LICENSE

- 18 (B) "SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED
- 19 UNDER THIS ARTICLE AS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (i) A COSMETOLOGIST.
- 21 (ii) AN ELECTROLOGIST.
- 22 (iii) AN ESTHETICIAN.
- 23 (iv) A MANICURIST.
- 24 (v) A NATURAL HAIR CULTURIST.
- 25 (vi) AN INSTRUCTOR.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
