A bill to amend 2000 PA 274, entitled "Large carnivore act,"

by amending section 22 (MCL 287.1122), as amended by 2013 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 22. (1) Sections 3, 4, AND 5 , and 6 do not apply to any of the following:
- 3 (a) An animal control shelter or animal protection shelter.
 - (b) A person licensed or approved by the department of natural resources of this state or by the United States fish and wildlife service FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE of the United States department of the interior. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR. This subdivision does not apply to a person in possession of 1 or more black bears under the authority of a permit to hold wildlife in captivity issued by the department of natural resources.

- 1 (c) A zoological park approved or accredited by the American

- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
