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HOUSE BILL No. 6193

June 12, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Calley, Marino, Webber and LaSata and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 558 (MCL 168.558), as amended by 2014 PA 94.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 558. (1) When filing a nominating petition, qualifying petition, filing fee, or affidavit of candidacy for a federal, county, state, city, township, village, metropolitan district, or school district office in any election, a candidate shall file with the officer with whom the petitions, fee, or affidavit is filed 2 copies of an affidavit of identity. A candidate nominated for a federal, state, county, city, township, or village office at a political party convention or caucus shall file an affidavit of identity within 1 business day after being nominated with the secretary of state. The affidavit of identity filing requirement does not apply to a candidate nominated for the office of president

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- 1 PRESIDENT of the United States or vice president VICE PRESIDENT of
- 2 the United States.
- 3 (2) An affidavit of identity shall MUST contain the
- 4 candidate's name AND RESIDENTIAL address; and ward and precinct
- 5 where registered, if qualified to vote at that election; a
- 6 statement that the candidate is a citizen of the United States; the
- 7 candidate's number of years of residence in the state and county;
- 8 THE TITLE OF THE OFFICE SOUGHT; A STATEMENT THAT THE CANDIDATE
- 9 MEETS THE CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE
- 10 OFFICE SOUGHT; other information that may be required to satisfy
- 11 the officer as to the identity of the candidate; AND the manner in
- 12 which the candidate wishes to have his or her name appear on the
- 13 ballot. ; and a statement that the candidate either is or is not
- 14 using a name, whether a given name, a surname, or otherwise, that
- 15 is not a name that he or she was given at birth. If a candidate is
- 16 using a name that is not a name that he or she was given at birth,
- 17 the candidate shall include on the affidavit of identity the
- 18 candidate's full former name.
- 19 (3) The requirement to indicate a name change on the affidavit
- 20 of identity does not apply if the name in question is 1 of the
- 21 following:
- 22 (a) A name that was formally changed at least 10 years before
- 23 filing as a candidate.
- 24 (b) A name that was changed in a certificate of naturalization
- 25 issued by a federal district court at the time the individual
- 26 became a naturalized citizen at least 10 years before filing as a
- 27 candidate.

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- 1 (c) A name that was changed because of marriage.
- 2 (d) A name that was changed because of divorce, but only if to
- 3 a legal name by which the individual was previously known.
- 4 (e) A name that constitutes a common law name as provided in
- 5 section 560b.
- **6** (4) An affidavit of identity shall **MUST** include a statement
- 7 that as of the date of the affidavit, all statements, reports, late
- 8 filing fees, and fines required of the candidate or any candidate
- 9 committee organized to support the candidate's election under the
- 10 Michigan campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 to 169.282,
- 11 have been filed or paid; and a statement that the candidate
- 12 acknowledges that making a false statement in the affidavit is
- 13 perjury, punishable by a fine up to \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for
- 14 up to 5 years, or both. If a candidate files the affidavit of
- 15 identity with an officer other than the county clerk or secretary
- 16 of state, the officer shall immediately forward to the county clerk
- 17 1 copy of the affidavit of identity by first-class mail. The county
- 18 clerk shall immediately forward 1 copy of the affidavit of identity
- 19 for state and federal candidates to the secretary of state by
- 20 first-class mail. An officer shall not certify to the board of
- 21 election commissioners the name of a candidate who fails to comply
- 22 with this section, OR THE NAME OF A CANDIDATE WHO EXECUTES AN
- 23 AFFIDAVIT OF IDENTITY THAT CONTAINS A FALSE STATEMENT WITH REGARD
- 24 TO ANY INFORMATION OR STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 25 (5) If petitions or filing fees are filed by or in—ON behalf
- 26 of a candidate for more than 1 office, either federal, state,
- 27 county, city, village, township, metropolitan district, or school

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- 1 district, the terms of which run concurrently or overlap, the
- 2 candidate so filing, or in ON behalf of whom petitions or fees were
- 3 so filed, shall select the 1 office to which his or her candidacy
- 4 is restricted within 3 days after the last day for the filing of
- 5 petitions or filing fees unless the petitions or filing fees are
- 6 filed for 2 offices that are combined or for offices that are not
- 7 incompatible. Failure to make the selection disqualifies a
- 8 candidate with respect to each office for which petitions or fees
- 9 were so filed and the name of the candidate shall MUST not be
- 10 printed upon the ballot for those offices. A vote cast for that
- 11 candidate at the ensuing primary or general election shall MUST not
- 12 be counted and is void.
- 13 (6) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION FOR PERJURY IS DISTINCT AND
- 14 SEPARATE FROM ANY VIOLATION OF THE MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE ACT,
