THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 202. (1) An employer shall not do any of the following:

 (a) Fail or refuse to hire or recruit, discharge, or otherwise discriminate against an individual with respect to employment, compensation, or a term, condition, or privilege of employment, because of religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, or marital status, OR ETHNIC HAIRSTYLE.
- (b) Limit, segregate, or classify an employee or applicant for employment in a way that deprives or tends to deprive the employee or applicant of an employment opportunity —or otherwise adversely affects the status of an THE employee or applicant because of religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, height, weight,

- 1 or marital status, OR ETHNIC HAIRSTYLE.
- 2 (c) Segregate, classify, or otherwise discriminate against a
