## **HOUSE BILL No. 6240**

June 12, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Chirkun, Howell, Love, Cambensy, Dianda, Geiss, Greimel, Gay-Dagnogo and Yanez and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1966 PA 331, entitled "Community college act of 1966,"

by amending the title and sections 128 and 131 (MCL 389.128 and 389.131), the title as amended by 2008 PA 359 and sections 128 and 131 as amended by 1998 PA 281.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to revise and consolidate the laws relating to community colleges; to provide for the creation of community college districts; to provide a charter for such districts; to provide for the government, control, and administration of such districts; to provide for the election of a board of trustees; to define the powers and duties of the board of trustees; to provide

- 1 for the assessment, levy, collection and return of taxes therefor;
- 2 to authorize community college districts to operate a new jobs
- 3 training program, enter into certain training agreements, and issue
- 4 bonds to finance the training program; TO GRANT CERTAIN POWERS,
- 5 DUTIES, AND AUTHORITY TO PUBLIC SAFETY AND POLICE OFFICERS OF A
- 6 COMMUNITY COLLEGE; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and
- 7 to repeal acts and parts of acts.
- 8 Sec. 128. (1) Subject to subsections (2), and (3), AND (4),
- 9 the board of trustees of a community college created under this act

- 18 (2) Before granting the powers and authority provided under

- 23 that board of trustees creates a public safety advisory committee.

- 11 SEXUAL VIOLENCE OR CONTACT, OR ASSAULT WITH A WEAPON, IN
- 12 CONSULTATION WITH THE CAMPUS CRIME COMMISSION AS PROVIDED IN THE

- 14 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION AND SECTION 131, "DOMESTIC
- 15 VIOLENCE" MEANS A VIOLATION OF SECTION 81(2), (3), (4), OR (5) OF
- 16 THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.81.
- 17 Sec. 131. (1) The public safety department or police
- 18 department of each community college shall submit monthly uniform
- 19 crime reports pertaining to crimes within the department's
- 20 jurisdiction to the department of state police in the same manner
- 21 as uniform crime reports are submitted under section 1 of 1968 PA
- 22 319, MCL 28.251.
- 23 (2) A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OR POLICE OFFICER GRANTED POWERS
- 24 AND AUTHORITY UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOTIFY THE CAMPUS CRIME
- 25 COMMISSION IF IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER
- 26 OR POLICE OFFICER RECEIVES INFORMATION THAT FIRST OR SECOND DEGREE
- 27 MURDER, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, OR A CRIME INVOLVING SEXUAL VIOLENCE OR

- 1 CONTACT, OR ASSAULT WITH A WEAPON, HAS OCCURRED ON PROPERTY OWNED
- 2 OR LEASED BY THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE. IF OTHERWISE GRANTED THE POWER
- 3 AND AUTHORITY UNDER THIS ACT, A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OR POLICE
- 4 OFFICER MAY CONDUCT A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION AND TAKE ACTION ON
- 5 THE INFORMATION BEFORE PROVIDING THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THIS
- 6 SUBSECTION.
- 7 (3) A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OR POLICE OFFICER WHO WILLFULLY
- 8 NEGLECTS TO PERFORM THE DUTY REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) IS
- 9 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
- 10 THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 12 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 13 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 14 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 6241 (request no.
