An act to establish and regulate a state institution of higher
education known as Saginaw valley state university; and VALLEY

governing board; TO GRANT CERTAIN POWERS, DUTIES, AND AUTHORITY TO
PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OF SAGINAW VALLEY STATE UNIVERSITY; AND TO
PRESCRIBE PENALTIES.
Sec. 5a. (1) The board may establish a public safety
department and prescribe the powers and duties of the public safety
