- 2 district OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY is
- 3 authorized to perform shall be conducted at a public meeting of the
- 4 board OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS held in compliance with the open
- **5** meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275. An act of the
- 6 board OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS is not valid unless the act is
 - authorized at a meeting by a majority vote of the members elected
- ${f 8}$ or appointed to and serving on the board ${f OR}$ ${f BOARD}$ ${f OF}$ ${f DIRECTORS}$ and
- a proper record is made of the vote.
