A bill to amend 2001 PA 142, entitled  
"Michigan memorial highway act,"  
(MCL 250.1001 to 250.2080) by adding section 26a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

**SEC. 26A. THE PORTION OF HIGHWAY M-10 IN THE CITY OF DETROIT  
BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION WITH HIGHWAY M-102 AND EXTENDING  
SOUTH TO THE INTERSECTION WITH HIGHWAY I-94 SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE  
"ARETHA FRANKLIN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".**

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
after the date it is enacted into law.
