

# HOUSE BILL No. 6539

November 28, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Marino and Noble and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1846 RS 158, entitled  
"Of offences against chastity, morality and decency,"  
by amending section 27 (MCL 752.527), as amended by 1991 PA 145;  
and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 27. ~~It shall be the duty of all sheriffs, and their~~  
2 ~~deputies, coroners, marshals, constables, and other peace officers,~~  
3 ~~all presiding elders, and ministers of the gospel, deacons,~~  
4 ~~stewards and official members of any church or religious society,~~  
5 ~~who may be present at the meeting of any assembly for religious~~  
6 ~~worship, which shall be interrupted or disturbed in the manner~~  
7 ~~prohibited, on sight to apprehend the offender, and take him or her~~

1 ~~before the district or municipal court of the judicial district or~~  
2 ~~municipality, to be proceeded against according to law.~~ **A PEACE**  
3 **OFFICER WHO IS ON DUTY SHALL APPREHEND AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, IN A**  
4 **MANNER PROHIBITED BY LAW, INTERRUPTS OR DISTURBS A MEETING OF AN**  
5 **ASSEMBLY FOR RELIGIOUS WORSHIP.**

6       Enacting section 1. Section 28 of 1846 RS 158, MCL 752.528, is  
7 repealed.

8       Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
9 after the date it is enacted into law.
