## **HOUSE BILL No. 6605**

December 19, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Anthony and Hammoud and referred to the Committee on Education Reform.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 380.3), as amended by 2016 PA 192.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. (1) "Area" as used in the phrase "area vocationaltechnical education program" or "area career and technical
education program" means the geographical territory, within the
boundaries of a K to 12 school district, an intermediate school
district, or a community college district, that is designated by
the department as the service area for the operation of an area
vocational-technical education program.

(2) "Area vocational-technical education program", "area career and technical education program", or "career and technical education program" means a program of organized, systematic
