## **HOUSE BILL No. 6607**

December 19, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Hammoud and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to provide for a disability identification card; to provide for its form and issuance; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
  - (a) "Department" means the department of state.
  - (b) "Disabled person" means a person who has a disability. As used in this subdivision, "disability" means that term as defined in section 103 of the persons with disabilities civil rights act, 1976 PA 220, MCL 37.1103.
  - Sec. 3. (1) A disabled person who is a resident of this state may apply to the department for a disability identification card.
    - (2) An application for a disability identification card shall

- 1 be on a form prescribed by the department and shall contain
- 2 information regarding the disabled person's disability, and other
- 3 information determined necessary by the department.
- 4 (3) A disability identification card issued under this section
- 5 may contain information regarding the types of accommodations
- 6 needed by the disabled person and information for a police officer
- 7 regarding how to interact with the disabled person.
- 8 (4) The department shall provide informational materials and
- 9 training to police officers regarding disability identification
- 10 cards. The information materials and training required by this
- 11 subsection shall also include protocols on interacting with
- 12 disabled persons.
- 13 (5) The department may charge a fee for issuing a disability
- 14 identification card.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 16 date it is enacted into law.
