A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 224 (MCL 750.224), as amended by 2006 PA 401.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 224. (1) A person shall not manufacture, sell, offer forsale, or possess any of the following:
- (a) A machine gun or firearm that shoots or is designed to
 shoot automatically more than 1 shot without manual reloading, by a
 single function of the trigger.
 - (b) A muffler or silencer.
 - (c) A bomb or bombshell.

- (d) A blackjack, slungshot, billy, metallic knuckles, sand club, sand bag, or bludgeon.
- (e) A device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance designed to render a person temporarily or permanently disabled by

- 2 (F) A 3-D PRINTED FIREARM.
