THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

- (a) "Field name" means the label or identification of an
 element of a computer data base DATABASE that contains a specific
 item of information, and includes but is not limited to a subject
 heading such as a column header, data dictionary, or record layout.
 - (b) "FOIA coordinator" means either of the following:
 - (i) An individual who is a public body.
 - (ii) An individual designated by a public body in accordance with section 6 to accept and process requests for public records under this act.
 - (c) "Person" means an individual, corporation, limited

- 2 governmental entity, or other legal entity. Person does not include

- **8** (f) "Software" means a set of statements or instructions that

- 15 (g) "Unusual circumstances" means any 1 or a combination of

- 21 (ii) The need to collect the requested public records from

- (h) "Writing" means handwriting, typewriting, printing,
- 26 photostating, photographing, photocopying, and every other means of
- 27 recording, and includes letters, words, pictures, sounds, or

- 2 paper tapes, photographic films or prints, microfilm, microfiche,

- 5 (i) "Written request" means a writing that asks for
- 6 information, and includes a writing transmitted by facsimile,
- 7 electronic mail, or other electronic means.
