SENATE BILL No. 87

February 1, 2017, Introduced by Senator JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to create a water affordability program; to create a water affordability fund to provide assistance to low-income state residents for water services; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "water
 affordability act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of health and human services.
 - (b) "Eligible customer" means a customer whose household income does not exceed 200% of the poverty guidelines, as published by the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
 - (c) "Fund" means the water affordability fund created in
