SENATE BILL No. 176

February 22, 2017, Introduced by Senator CASPERSON and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1996 PA 299, entitled

"An act to regulate tourist-oriented directional signs on certain rural roads; and to impose certain duties upon the state transportation department,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 247.401), as amended by 2004 PA 528.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the state transportation department.
 - (b) "Eligible attraction" means a tourist-oriented activity that is all of the following:
 - (i) Within 10 miles of the rural road for which a tourist-oriented directional sign is sought, unless otherwise restricted or permitted by the department.
 - (ii) Not visible from the rural road for which a touristoriented directional sign is sought UNLESS A SIGN FOR AN ELIGIBLE

- 14 (d) "Tourist-oriented activity" means a lawful cultural,
- 15 historical, recreational, educational, or commercial activity that
- 16 is annually attended by 2,000 or more people and for which a major
- 17 portion of the activity's income or visitors are derived during the
- 18 normal business season from motorists not residing in the immediate
- 19 area of the activity.
- (e) "Tourist-oriented directional sign" means a sign used to
- 21 provide motorists with advanced notice of a tourist-oriented
- 22 activity.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
