Sec. 4. (1) Subject to the exceptions specified in this act,

2 the minimum hourly wage rate is: 3 (a) Before September 1, 2014, \$7.40. (b) Beginning September 1, 2014, \$8.15. 5 (c) Beginning January 1, 2016, \$8.50. (d) Beginning January 1, 2017, \$8.90. (e) Beginning January 1, 2018, \$9.25.\$15.00. 7 8 (2) Every January beginning in January 2019, the state treasurer shall adjust the minimum wage by an amount determined by 9 10 the state treasurer at the end of the preceding calendar year to 11 reflect the average annual percentage change in the consumer price
