SENATE BILL No. 201

February 28, 2017, Introduced by Senator HOOD and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 81F. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A
- 2 PERSON WHO ASSAULTS, BATTERS, OR ASSAULTS AND BATTERS AN INDIVIDUAL
- 3 WHO PERFORMS HIS OR HER DUTIES AS A SPORTS OFFICIAL IMMEDIATELY
- 4 BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER A SPORTING EVENT, OR AT ANY OTHER TIME IF
- 5 THE ASSAULT, BATTERY, OR ASSAULT AND BATTERY DIRECTLY ARISES FROM
- 6 THE SPORTS OFFICIAL'S EXECUTION OF HIS OR HER DUTY AS A SPORTS
- 7 OFFICIAL, IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
 - NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 9 (2) A PERSON WHO ASSAULTS, BATTERS, OR ASSAULTS AND BATTERS AN
- .0 INDIVIDUAL WHO PERFORMS HIS OR HER DUTIES AS A SPORTS OFFICIAL
- 11 IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER A SPORTING EVENT, OR AT ANY

- 18 ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION AS THE VIOLATION OF THIS

- 20 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 21 (A) "SERIOUS IMPAIRMENT OF A BODY FUNCTION" MEANS THAT TERM AS
- 22 DEFINED IN SECTION 58C OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300,
- 23 MCL 257.58C.
- 24 (B) "SPORTING EVENT" MEANS AN ORGANIZED COMPETITIVE ATHLETIC
- 25 ACTIVITY BETWEEN 2 OR MORE INDIVIDUALS.
- 26 (C) "SPORTS OFFICIAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO OFFICIALLY
- 27 ADMINISTERS OR OFFICIALLY ASSISTS IN ADMINISTERING THE RULES AT ANY

- 1 SPORTING EVENT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A REFEREE.
- 2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 3 after the date it is enacted into law.
