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SENATE BILL No. 213

March 2, 2017, Introduced by Senator MACGREGOR and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 16285 and 16287 (MCL 333.16285 and 333.16287), as added by 2016 PA 359.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 16285. (1) A health professional who is providing a telehealth service TO A PATIENT may prescribe the patient a drug if both of the following are met:
 - (a) The health professional is a prescriber.
 - (b) The drug is not a controlled substance. IF THE HEALTH

 PROFESSIONAL IS PRESCRIBING A DRUG THAT IS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE,

 THE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ACT

 APPLICABLE TO THAT HEALTH PROFESSIONAL FOR PRESCRIBING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.

(2) A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WHO PRESCRIBES A DRUG UNDER

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- 1 SUBSECTION (1) SHALL COMPLY WITH BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) IF THE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL CONSIDERS IT MEDICALLY
- 3 NECESSARY, HE OR SHE SHALL PROVIDE THE PATIENT WITH A REFERRAL FOR
- 4 OTHER HEALTH CARE SERVICES THAT ARE GEOGRAPHICALLY ACCESSIBLE TO
- 5 THE PATIENT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, EMERGENCY SERVICES.
- 6 (B) AFTER PROVIDING A TELEHEALTH SERVICE, THE HEALTH
- 7 PROFESSIONAL, OR A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WHO IS ACTING UNDER THE
- 8 DELEGATION OF THE DELEGATING HEALTH PROFESSIONAL, SHALL MAKE
- 9 HIMSELF OR HERSELF AVAILABLE TO PROVIDE FOLLOW-UP HEALTH CARE
- 10 SERVICES TO THE PATIENT OR REFER THE PATIENT TO ANOTHER HEALTH
- 11 PROFESSIONAL FOR FOLLOW-UP HEALTH CARE SERVICES.

- 13 SHALL promulgate rules to implement sections 16284 and 16285.
