

SENATE BILL No. 237

March 14, 2017, Introduced by Senator SCHUITMAKER and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1503.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1503. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT THE
3 CURRICULUM FOR HEALTH EDUCATION REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 1502
4 INCLUDES A PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION ON PRESCRIPTION OPIOID DRUG
5 ABUSE.

6 (2) NOT LATER THAN JULY 1, 2018, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP
7 OR ADOPT, AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND PUBLIC SCHOOL
8 ACADEMIES, A MODEL PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION ON PRESCRIPTION OPIOID
9 DRUG ABUSE BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS DEVELOPED BY THE

1 PRESCRIPTION DRUG AND OPIOID ABUSE COMMISSION UNDER SECTION 7113A
2 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, MCL 333.7113A. THE MODEL PROGRAM OF
3 INSTRUCTION ADOPTED OR DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE AT
4 LEAST INSTRUCTION ON THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG EPIDEMIC AND THE
5 CONNECTION BETWEEN PRESCRIPTION OPIOID DRUG ABUSE AND ADDICTION TO
6 OTHER DRUGS.

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
8 after the date it is enacted into law.

9 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
10 unless Senate Bill No. 236

11 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
