## **SENATE BILL No. 271**

March 23, 2017, Introduced by Senators KNOLLENBERG, PAVLOV and HOPGOOD and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

by amending section 1284b (MCL 380.1284b), as amended by 2006 PA 235.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1284b. (1) Until subsection (2) applies to the school
- 2 district, public school academy, or intermediate school district,
- 3 the THE board of a school district or intermediate school district
- 4 or board of directors of a public school academy shall ensure that
- 5 the ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE MET:
  - (A) THE district's or public school academy's schools are not in session on the Friday before Labor day. DAY.
  - (B) THE DISTRICT'S OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY'S SCHOOLS ARE NOT IN SESSION ON ANY MONDAY OR FRIDAY IN AUGUST.
