A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 32517.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 32517. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 2129, THE DEPARTMENT
- 2 SHALL NOT GRANT AN EASEMENT OVER, THROUGH, UNDER, OR UPON
- 3 BOTTOMLANDS OF THE GREAT LAKES FOR A PIPELINE TO TRANSPORT CRUDE
- 4 OIL OR LIQUID PETROLEUM PRODUCTS.
- 5 (2) THE OWNER OF ANY PIPELINE AUTHORIZED TO TRANSPORT CRUDE
 - OIL OR LIQUID PETROLEUM PRODUCTS AND FOR WHICH AN EASEMENT OVER,
- 7 THROUGH, UNDER, OR UPON BOTTOMLANDS OF THE GREAT LAKES WAS GRANTED
 - BY THIS STATE BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL DO
 - BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (A) BY 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION,
- 11 PROVIDE THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE WITH A PRELIMINARY

- 3 (B) BY 120 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION,

- 19 SUBSECTION (2) (B), THAT THE PUBLIC TRUST IN THE WATERS OF THE GREAT
- 20 LAKES IS AT RISK OF BEING IMPAIRED OR SUBSTANTIALLY ADVERSELY
- 21 AFFECTED, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL GIVE WRITTEN NOTICE OF ITS
- 22 DETERMINATION TO THE OPERATOR OF THE PIPELINE. UNLESS THE OPERATOR
- 23 CURES THE RISKS IDENTIFIED IN THE ANALYSIS WITHIN THE PERIOD OF
- 24 TIME SPECIFIED BY THE EASEMENT OR, IF NO PERIOD IS SPECIFIED BY THE
- 25 EASEMENT, WITHIN 90 DAYS, THE EASEMENT FOR THE PIPELINE IS
- 26 TERMINATED AND THE OPERATOR SHALL DECOMMISSION THE PIPELINE.
- 27 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "GREAT LAKES" MEANS THE GREAT

- 1 LAKES AND THEIR CONNECTING WATERS, INCLUDING LAKE ST. CLAIR.
- 2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 3 after the date it is enacted into law.
