May 9, 2017, Introduced by Senators SCHUITMAKER and O'BRIEN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 136.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 136. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY CIRCUMCISE, EXCISE,
- 2 OR INFIBULATE THE WHOLE OR ANY PART OF THE LABIA MAJORA OR LABIA
- 3 MINORA OR CLITORIS OF ANOTHER PERSON WHO IS LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF
- 4 AGE.
- 5 (2) A SURGICAL OPERATION IS NOT A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IF
- 6 THE OPERATION IS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) NECESSARY TO THE HEALTH OF THE PERSON ON WHOM IT IS
- 8 PERFORMED AND IS PERFORMED BY A PERSON LICENSED TO PERFORM THAT
- 9 OPERATION UNDER THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1101
- 10 TO 333.25211.
 - (B) PERFORMED ON A PERSON IN LABOR OR WHO HAS JUST GIVEN BIRTH

- 11 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS OR A FINE OF
- 12 NOT MORE THAN \$25,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 13 (6) IT IS NOT A DEFENSE TO PROSECUTION UNDER THIS SECTION THAT
- 14 THE PERSON ON WHOM THE OPERATION IS PERFORMED, OR ANY OTHER PERSON,
- 15 BELIEVES THAT THE OPERATION IS REQUIRED AS A MATTER OF CUSTOM OR
- 16 RITUAL.
- 17 (7) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM BEING CHARGED
- 18 WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW
- 19 ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION AS THE VIOLATION OF THIS
- 20 SECTION.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
