

# SENATE BILL No. 417

May 31, 2017, Introduced by Senator O'BRIEN and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 62, entitled  
"Human trafficking notification act,"  
by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 752.1032 and 752.1033).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2       (a) "Adult entertainment establishment" means either of the  
3 following:

4       (i) An adult entertainment establishment that holds a topless  
5 activity permit under section 916(3) of the Michigan liquor control  
6 code of 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL 436.1916.

7       (ii) Any other retail establishment that provides adult-  
8 oriented entertainment in which performers disrobe or perform in an  
9 unclothed state for entertainment.

10       (b) "Department" means the department of licensing and

1 regulatory affairs.

2 (c) "Human trafficking notice" means the notice described in  
3 section 5.

4 (D) "LIQUOR LICENSEE" MEANS AN ENTITY OTHER THAN AN ENTITY  
5 DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (A) THAT IS LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC  
6 LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES UNDER THE MICHIGAN LIQUOR  
7 CONTROL CODE OF 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL 436.1101 TO 436.2303.

8 Sec. 3. (1) The department of transportation shall post a  
9 human trafficking notice on the premises of each rest stop and  
10 welcome facility in this state in the manner described in this act  
11 and as required by the department under this act.

12 (2) Each local unit of government that operates a rest stop or  
13 welcome facility shall post a human trafficking notice on the  
14 premises of that rest stop or welcome facility in the manner  
15 described in this act and as required by the department under this  
16 act.

17 (3) Each local unit of government, or authority allowed by  
18 law, that provides bus or rail transportation services to the  
19 public shall post a human trafficking notice on the premises of any  
20 station that provides those services in the manner described in  
21 this act and as required by the department under this act.

22 (4) Each of the following shall post a human trafficking  
23 notice on its premises in the manner described in this act and as  
24 required by the department under this act:

25 (a) Any entity that owns property that has been found by a  
26 court to constitute a public nuisance due to acts of prostitution  
27 or human trafficking being conducted on the property or arising out

1 of the ownership or use of the property.

2 (b) An adult entertainment establishment.

3 (c) Public airports.

4 (D) A LIQUOR LICENSEE.

5 (E) A TRUCK STOP.

6 (F) THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY ROOM, OR TRAUMA CENTER

7 LOCATED IN A HOSPITAL LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 17 OF THE PUBLIC

8 HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 TO 333.22260.

9 (G) AN URGENT CARE CENTER.

10 (H) A FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR.

11 (I) A JOB RECRUITMENT CENTER.

12 (J) A STADIUM OR ARENA FOR USE BY A PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAM.

13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

14 after the date it is enacted into law.
