

SENATE BILL No. 557

September 13, 2017, Introduced by Senator HANSEN and referred to the Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1964 PA 105, entitled

"An act to provide for reproduction of records of this state, political subdivisions of this state, and municipal courts of record; and to provide for the use of those reproductions as evidence,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 691.1101), as amended by 1992 PA 187.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. If a department, commission, board, or officer of this
2 state, a political subdivision, or a municipal court of record
3 reproduces pursuant to the records ~~media~~-REPRODUCTION act, 1992 PA
4 116, MCL 24.401 TO 24.406, records kept by or in the department,
5 commission, board, office, or court, the department, commission,
6 board, officer, or court may cause the original records to be
7 disposed of or destroyed pursuant to sections 201, 285, 287, and
8 289 of the management and budget act, ~~Act No. 431 of the Public~~

~~Acts of 1984, being sections 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1201, 18.1285,~~
~~18.1287, and 18.1289, of the Michigan Compiled Laws, if applicable,~~
~~and section 5 of Act No. 271 of the Public Acts of 1913, as~~
~~amended, being section 399.5 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.~~ **SECTION**
11 OF THE MICHIGAN HISTORY CENTER ACT, 2016 PA 470, MCL 399.811. A
record of a municipal court of record shall not be disposed of or
destroyed unless the record has been in the custody of the court
for at least 6 years.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
after the date it is enacted into law.

Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
unless Senate Bill No. 564

of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
