A bill to amend 2016 PA 469, entitled "Michigan historical commission act," by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 399.832 and 399.833).

- (a) "Commission" means the Michigan historical commissioncreated in section 3.
 - (b) "Department" means the department of natural resources.
 - (c) "Michigan historical HISTORY center" means the Michigan historical HISTORY center established in the Michigan historical HISTORY center act.
 - Sec. 3. (1) The Michigan historical commission is created within the department. The commission shall consist of the following members:
 - (a) One member appointed by the speaker of the house of

- 3 (c) Seven members appointed by the governor by and with the

- 14 (9) The commission shall do all of the following:
- 15 (a) Advise the department on its responsibilities related to
- 16 the collection of historical artifacts and materials, and the
- 17 dissemination of information on Michigan history.
- 18 (b) Perform responsibilities requested by the director,
- 19 including both of the following:
- 20 (i) Collaborating and participating in Michigan history
- 21 related initiatives, activities, efforts, and projects.
- 22 (ii) Assisting the Michigan historical HISTORY center in
- 23 preparing an annual report to the governor and both houses of the
- 24 legislature on Michigan history activities.
- 25 (c) Annually review the fee schedule for admissions fees at
- 26 the Michigan historical HISTORY center and make recommendations on
- 27 any appropriate adjustments to those fees. If the commission

- 1 determines that an adjustment to admission fees is appropriate, the
- 2 commission shall submit a report to the chairpersons, vice-
- 3 chairpersons, and minority vice-chairpersons of the senate and
- 4 house appropriation subcommittees on natural resources that does
- 5 all of the following:
- 6 (i) Includes a recommended admission fee schedule.
- 7 (ii) Provides a rationale for the recommended admission fee
- 8 schedule.
- 9 (iii) Makes recommendations on the uses of any increases in
- 10 the recommended admission fee schedule.
- 11 (d) Carry out other responsibilities as provided by law.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 13 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 14 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 15 unless all the following bills of the 99th Legislature are enacted
- 16 into law:
