SENATE BILL No. 589

September 27, 2017, Introduced by Senators MACGREGOR, BRANDENBURG, HILDENBRAND and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1997 PA 55, entitled "Electric patrol vehicle act," by amending sections 2, 4, and 5 (MCL 257.1572, 257.1574, and 257.1575).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Electric patrol vehicle" means an electrically powered motor vehicle designed to carry not more than 4 persons, at a speed OF not more than 25 miles per hour, having not less than 4-2 OR 3 wheels and having an unloaded weight of not more than 1,300 pounds.
 - (b) "Political subdivision" means a village, city, township, county, or a university of this state.
 - (C) "SIDEWALK" MEANS A PAVED PUBLIC SIDEWALK INTENDED FOR PEDESTRIAN USE SITUATED OUTSIDE OF AND ADJACENT TO THE IMPROVED
