## **SENATE BILL No. 672**

November 29, 2017, Introduced by Senator PAVLOV and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1963 PA 181, entitled
"Motor carrier safety act of 1963,"
by amending section 5 (MCL 480.15), as amended by 2017 PA 116.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) In the case of intrastate transportation, the
- 2 provisions of 49 CFR 391.21 relating to application for employment,
- 3 49 CFR 391.23 relating to investigations and inquiries, 49 CFR
- 4 391.31 relating to road tests, 49 CFR part 395 relating to hours of
- 5 service, 49 CFR 383.71 and 391.41 to 391.45, to the extent that
- 6 they require a driver to be medically qualified or examined and to
- 7 have a medical examiner's certificate on his or her person, and the
- 8 provisions of this act relating to files and records do not apply
- 9 to a farm vehicle driver as defined in 49 CFR 390.5.
  - (2) For intrastate transportation, the provisions of this act

- 1 do DOES not apply to a self-propelled implement of husbandry or an
- 2 implement of husbandry being drawn by a farm tractor or another
- 3 implement of husbandry.
- 4 (3) The provisions of this act related to driver
- 5 qualifications do not apply to an employee of a public utility,
- 6 telephone, or cable television company service if the employee is
- 7 not otherwise being used as a regularly employed driver and is not
- 8 operating a vehicle that meets the definition of a commercial motor
- **9** vehicle in 49 CFR part 383.
- 10 (4) This act and the rules promulgated under this act do not
- 11 apply to a commercial motor vehicle owned and operated by a unit of
- 12 government or its employees, except as otherwise provided by this
- 13 act, and except for 49 CFR 383.71(h) and all of 49 CFR parts 382,
- 14 391, 392, and 393. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 15 subsection, the provisions of 49 CFR 391.41 to 391.49 do not apply
- 16 to a firefighter operating a commercial motor vehicle that is
- 17 necessary to firefighting or the preservation of life or property,
- 18 or the execution of an emergency governmental function of a local
- 19 unit of government or government authority.
- 20 (5) A combination of vehicles with an actual combination gross
- 21 vehicle weight or a gross combination weight rating of 26,000
- 22 pounds or less, if the trailer or semitrailer has an actual gross
- 23 vehicle weight or gross vehicle weight rating of 15,000 pounds or
- 24 less, may be equipped with surge brakes for intrastate operation as
- 25 allowed by section 705(1)(c) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
- 26 300, MCL 257.705. Vehicles of any size that are transporting
- 27 hazardous materials in an amount that requires placarding or

- 1 vehicles that are designed to transport more than 8 passengers,
- 2 including the driver, shall not be equipped with surge brakes for
- 3 intrastate operation.
- 4 (6) Except for the purpose of granting a waiver in accordance
- 5 with section 53 of the pupil transportation act, 1990 PA 187, MCL
- 6 257.1853, this act and the rules promulgated under this act do not
- 7 apply to a school bus as defined in section 7 of the pupil
- 8 transportation act, 1990 PA 187, MCL 257.1807.
- 9 (7) Except for section 6, this act and the rules promulgated
- 10 under this act do not apply to a motor bus as defined in, and for
- 11 which a certificate of authority was issued under, the motor bus
- 12 transportation act, 1982 PA 432, MCL 474.101 to 474.141.
- 13 (7) (8) A motor carrier operating entirely in intrastate
- 14 commerce solely within this state shall not permit or require an
- 15 operator of a commercial motor vehicle engaged in seasonal
- 16 construction-related activities, regardless of the number of motor
- 17 carriers using the operator's services, to do either of the
- 18 following:
- 19 (a) Operate for any period after having been on duty 70 hours
- 20 in any 7 consecutive days or having been on duty 80 hours in any
- 21 period of 8 consecutive days.
- (b) Operate more than 12 hours or be on duty more than 16
- 23 hours in any day.
- 24 (8) (9) As used in this section:
- 25 (a) "Farm tractor" means that term as defined in section 16 of
- the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.16.
- 27 (b) "Implement of husbandry" means that term as defined in

- 1 section 21 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.21.
- 2 (c) "Public utility" means a person that operates equipment or
- 3 facilities for producing, generating, transmitting, delivering, or
- 4 furnishing gas or electricity for the production of light, heat, or
- 5 power for the public for compensation.
- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 7 after the date it is enacted into law.
