## **SENATE BILL No. 727**

December 13, 2017, Introduced by Senator PAVLOV and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1531i (MCL 380.1531i), as added by 2009 PA 202.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1531i. (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall
- 2 establish a process for a person AN INDIVIDUAL to earn an interim
- 3 teaching certificate under this section that qualifies the person
- 4 INDIVIDUAL to teach in the public schools and to earn a Michigan
- 5 teaching certificate using the process under this section. The
- 6 process shall meet all applicable requirements for an alternative
- 7 teaching certification process under the no child left behind act
- 8 of 2001, Public Law 107-110. The process shall not allow for an
- 9 interim teaching certificate for special education.
  - (2) The process established under subsection (1) shall provide

- 1 that the superintendent of public instruction will grant an interim
- 2 teaching certificate to a person AN INDIVIDUAL who meets all of the
- 3 following:
- 4 (a) Is a participant in an alternative teaching program that
- 5 is approved by the superintendent of public instruction. To be
- 6 approved, a program provider shall demonstrate to the satisfaction
- 7 of the superintendent of public instruction that it meets all of
- 8 the following:
- 9 (i) Provides for its participants an intensive training
- 10 program in teaching that is determined by the superintendent of
- 11 public instruction to constitute the equivalent of at least 12
- 12 college credit hours and that includes training in at least all of
- 13 the following subject areas:
- 14 (A) Child development or child psychology.
- 15 (B) Family and community relationships.
- 16 (C) Diverse learners.
- 17 (D) Instructional strategies.
- 18 (E) A form of field-based experience in a classroom setting.
- 19 (ii) Has a proven record of producing successful teachers in 1
- 20 or more other states or is modeled after a program that has a
- 21 proven record of producing successful teachers. in 1 or more other
- 22 states.
- 23 (iii) Accepts for participation only persons INDIVIDUALS who
- 24 meet the requirements of subdivision (b).
- 25 (b) Holds a bachelor's, master's, doctorate, or professional
- 26 degree from a regionally accredited college or university with a
- 27 COHORT grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or the

- 1 equivalent on another scale, as determined by the superintendent of
- public instruction.
- 3 (c) Passes both the basic skills examination and the
- 4 appropriate available subject area examination for each subject
- 5 area in which he or she applies to be certified.
- 6 (3) A person AN INDIVIDUAL earning a provisional MICHIGAN
- 7 TEACHING certificate USING THE PROCESS under this section will be
- 8 subject to provisions of administrative rules governing teachers,
- 9 as established by the superintendent of public instruction.
- 10 (4) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who possesses an interim teaching
- 11 certificate under this section may be employed to teach in a public
- 12 school in the same manner as a person AN INDIVIDUAL holding a
- 13 Michigan teaching certificate issued under section 1531 if all of
- 14 the following requirements are met:
- 15 (a) While the person-INDIVIDUAL is teaching under an interim
- 16 teaching certificate, the school district or public school academy
- 17 in which the person-INDIVIDUAL is teaching provides intensive
- 18 observation and coaching in a manner and to the extent prescribed
- 19 by the superintendent of public instruction.
- 20 (b) The person-INDIVIDUAL is making satisfactory progress
- 21 toward meeting the requirements for being awarded a Michigan
- 22 teaching certificate under section 1531, as established by the
- 23 superintendent of public instruction under subsection (5).
- 24 (5) The superintendent of public instruction shall develop
- 25 standards for granting a person AN INDIVIDUAL a Michigan teaching
- 26 certificate issued under section 1531 after the person\_INDIVIDUAL
- 27 has demonstrated satisfactory teaching performance for 3 years

- 4 (6) The superintendent of public instruction shall promulgate
- 5 rules that he or she considers necessary to implement this section.
- 6 (7) As used in this section, "basic skills examination",
- 7 "elementary certification examination" —and "subject area
- 8 examination" mean those terms as defined in section 1531.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 10 after the date it is enacted into law.
