

# SENATE BILL No. 730

December 13, 2017, Introduced by Senator SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled  
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"  
by amending section 8151 (MCL 600.8151), as amended by 2012 PA 33.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 8151. (1) ~~Except as provided in subsection (2), the~~ **THE**  
2       eighty-sixth district consists of the counties of Grand Traverse,  
3       Antrim, and Leelanau, is a district of the first class, and has ~~3~~2  
4       judges.

~~election or reelection to that office.~~ JANUARY 1, 2018, BOTH OF THE  
FOLLOWING APPLY:

(A) UNDER SECTION 810A, THE PROBATE JUDGE FOR THE COUNTY OF  
ANTRIM SHALL SERVE AS JUDGE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH DISTRICT WITHIN  
ANTRIM COUNTY.

(B) UNDER SECTION 810A, THE PROBATE JUDGE FOR THE COUNTY OF  
LEELANAU SHALL SERVE AS JUDGE OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH DISTRICT WITHIN  
LEELANAU COUNTY.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
after the date it is enacted into law.
