THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1167. (1) NOT LATER THAN THE BEGINNING OF THE 2018-2019
- 2 SCHOOL YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A TRAINING
- 3 PROGRAM TO PROVIDE RESOURCES AND PROGRAMMING TO PUPILS IN GRADES 9
- 4 TO 12 WHO ARE INTERESTED IN A CAREER IN TEACHING AND WHO ARE
- 5 MEMBERS OF GROUPS THAT ARE UNDERREPRESENTED IN THE TEACHING
- 6 PROFESSION IN THIS STATE.
- 7 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING WITH RESPECT
- 8 TO THE TRAINING PROGRAM DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED UNDER SUBSECTION

- 10 (A) CREATE A PROCESS FOR NOMINATION AND ADMISSION OF PUPILS TO
- 11 THE PROGRAM.

- 22 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE AN ANNUAL STIPEND OF UP TO
- 23 \$500.00 EACH SCHOOL YEAR FOR UP TO 4 SCHOOL YEARS TO A PUPIL WHO
- 24 PARTICIPATES IN THE TRAINING PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (2).
- 25 (4) IF A PUPIL FAILS TO ATTEND A CONFERENCE UNDER SUBSECTION
- 26 (2) (E) OR VIOLATES A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (2) (G), THE
- 27 PUPIL SHALL REPAY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE ENTIRE STIPEND AWARDED TO

- 2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 3 after the date it is enacted into law.
