SENATE BILL No. 920

March 21, 2018, Introduced by Senators BOOHER, JONES, MACGREGOR and CASPERSON and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 2016 PA 436, entitled "Unmanned aircraft systems act,"

(MCL 259.301 to 259.331) by adding section 21a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21A. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY AND
- 2 INTENTIONALLY OPERATE AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM IN A MANNER THAT
- 3 INTERFERES WITH THE OPERATIONS OF A KEY FACILITY.
- 4 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "KEY FACILITY" MEANS A KEY
- 5 FACILITY AS DEFINED IN SECTION 45A OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931
- 6 PA 328, MCL 750.45A, OR A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OR OTHER LAW
- 7 ENFORCEMENT FACILITY.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- after the date it is enacted into law.
