

SENATE BILL No. 921

March 21, 2018, Introduced by Senators BOOHER, JONES, MACGREGOR and
CASPERSON and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 45a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 45A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY USE AN UNMANNED
2 AIRCRAFT IN A MANNER THAT INTERFERES WITH THE OPERATIONS OF A KEY
3 FACILITY.

4 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
5 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF
6 NOT MORE THAN \$2,500.00, OR BOTH.

7 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

8 (A) "KEY FACILITY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 552C.

1 (B) "UNMANNED AIRCRAFT" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
2 3 OF THE UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS ACT, 2016 PA 436, MCL 259.303.

3 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
4 after the date it is enacted into law.
