## SENATE BILL No. 923

March 21, 2018, Introduced by Senators PROOS, ZORN, PAVLOV, HORN, HANSEN and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 234.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 234. (1) SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION, ON REQUEST OF A SMALL
- 2 DISTILLER, ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION
- 3 SHALL PAY THE SMALL DISTILLER 1/2 OF THE GROSS PROFIT DESCRIBED IN
- 4 SECTION 233(1) THAT THE COMMISSION RECEIVED IN A CALENDAR YEAR ON
- 5 THE SALE OF SPIRITS MANUFACTURED BY THE SMALL DISTILLER IF THE
- 6 SPIRITS ARE PRODUCED WITH AT LEAST 40% OF ITS DISTILLED GRAIN GROWN
- 7 IN THIS STATE. A SMALL DISTILLER SHALL FILE THE REQUEST NOT LATER
  - THAN APRIL 15 OF THE YEAR AFTER THE CALENDAR YEAR FOR WHICH PAYMENT

- 1 IS REQUESTED. THE COMMISSION SHALL MAKE THE PAYMENT TO THE SMALL
- 2 DISTILLER WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF A REQUEST UNDER THIS

- 4 (2) A SMALL DISTILLER REQUESTING A PAYMENT UNDER SUBSECTION
- 5 (1) SHALL KEEP A COMPLETE AND ACCURATE SET OF RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS
- 6 OF ALL TRANSACTIONS PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION OF ITS DISTILLERY,
- 7 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS OF ALL
- 8 DISTILLED GRAIN RECEIVED IN OR WITHDRAWN FROM THE DISTILLERY, ALL
- 9 ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORMS IN THE SMALL DISTILLER'S POSSESSION, COPIES OF
- 10 ALL CONTRACTS, AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORMS RETURNED TO AND SETTLED BY
- 11 THE SMALL DISTILLER. THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL
- 12 DEVELOPMENT MAY EXAMINE THE RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS PERTAINING TO THE
- 13 SMALL DISTILLER'S DISTILLED GRAIN HANDLING BUSINESS AT ANY TIME
- 14 DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS.
- 15 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 16 (A) "ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM" MEANS A SCALE WEIGHT TICKET, A LOAD
- 17 SLIP, OR ANY OTHER EVIDENCE OF DEPOSIT ISSUED BY A SMALL DISTILLER
- 18 OR THE SMALL DISTRILLER'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO A DEPOSITOR
- 19 THAT IDENTIFIES THE DISTILLED GRAIN BEING TRANSFERRED FROM
- 20 POSSESSION OF THE DEPOSITOR TO THE POSSESSION OF THE SMALL
- 21 DISTILLER.
- 22 (B) "DEPOSITOR" MEANS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 23 (i) A PERSON THAT DELIVERS DISTILLED GRAIN TO A SMALL
- 24 DISTILLER FOR STORAGE, PROCESSING, SHIPMENT, OR SALE AND THAT HAS
- 25 TITLE TO DISTILLED GRAIN AT THE TIME OF DELIVERY.
- 26 (ii) A PERSON THAT OWNS OR THAT IS THE LEGAL HOLDER OF AN
- 27 ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM ISSUED BY A DEPOSITOR FOR DISTILLED GRAIN.

- 2 (i) DRY BARLEY.
- 3 (*ii*) OATS.
- 4 (iii) A SMALL GRAIN.
- 5 (iv) A CEREAL GRAIN.
- 6 (v) POTATO.
- 7 (vi) CORN.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 9 unless Senate Bill No. 579 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- **10** law.
