A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act,"

by amending section 411 (MCL 32.811), as amended by 2000 PA 472.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 411. (1) A person AN INDIVIDUAL who has completed not less than 20 years of active service with the national guard

 NATIONAL GUARD or defense force, or both, may retire and receive retirement pay under 1 or more of the following circumstances:
 - (a) Attainment of THE INDIVIDUAL IS 62 years of age OR OLDER.
 - (b) Ineligibility, because of federal law or regulation, for further federal recognition in the person's—INDIVIDUAL'S current grade because of age or length of service, and termination of the person's—INDIVIDUAL'S commission or enlistment in the national guard—NATIONAL GUARD of the United States.
