June 7, 2018, Introduced by Senator EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 288, entitled "Probate code of 1939,"

by amending section 60 of chapter X (MCL 710.60), as amended by 2006 PA 352.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 60. (1) After the entry of an order of adoption, if the
- 2 adoptee's name is changed, the adoptee shall be known and called by
- 3 the new name. The person or persons adopting the adoptee then
- 4 become the parent or parents of the adoptee under the law as though
- 5 the adopted person had been born to the adopting parents and are
- 6 liable for all the duties and entitled to all the rights of
- 7 parents.
 - (2) After entry of the order of adoption, there is no

- 1 distinction between the rights and duties of natural progeny and
- 2 adopted persons, and the adopted person becomes an heir at law of
- 3 the adopting parent or parents and an heir at law of the lineal and
- 4 collateral kindred of the adopting parent or parents. After entry
- 5 of the order of adoption, except as provided in section 2114(2)
- 6 2119 of the estates and protected individuals code, 1998 PA 386,
- 7 MCL 700.2114, 700.2119, an adopted child is no longer an heir at
- 8 law of a parent whose rights have been terminated under this
- 9 chapter or chapter XIIA or the lineal or collateral kindred of that
- 10 parent, nor is an adopted adult an heir at law of a person who was
- 11 his or her parent at the time the order of adoption was entered or
- 12 the lineal or collateral kindred of that person, except that a
- 13 right, title, or interest that has vested before entry of the final
- 14 order of adoption is not divested by that order.
- 15 (3) This section does not prohibit the filing of an action or
- 16 entry of an order for grandparenting time as provided in section 7b
- 17 of the child custody act of 1970, 1970 PA 91, MCL 722.27b.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 19 unless Senate Bill No. 1056
- of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
