## **SENATE BILL No. 1099**

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1945 PA 327, entitled "Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan," by amending section 80f (MCL 259.80f), as added by 2001 PA 225.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 80f. (1) An individual shall not possess, carry, or attempt to possess or carry any of the following in a sterile area of a commercial airport:
- 4 (a) Firearm.A FIREARM.
  - (b) Explosive.AN EXPLOSIVE.
    - (c) Knife A KNIFE with a blade of any length.
    - (d) Razor, A RAZOR, box cutter, or item with a similar blade.
    - (e) <del>Dangerous A DANGEROUS</del> weapon.
    - (2) Except as provided in subsection (3), an individual who

- 1 violates subsection (1) is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 2 imprisonment for not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than
- 3 \$1,000.00, or both.
- 4 (3) An individual who violates subsection (1) while doing any
- 5 of the following is quilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment
- 6 for not more than 10 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000.00,
- 7 or both:
- 8 (a) Getting on or attempting to get on an aircraft.
- 9 (b) Placing, attempting to place, or attempting to have placed
- 10 on an aircraft an item listed in subsection (1).
- (c) Committing or attempting to commit a felony.
- 12 (4) This section does not apply to any of the following:
- 13 (a) A peace officer of a duly authorized police agency of this

- 16 (b) An individual regularly employed by the department of

- 23 OR COAST GUARD while possessing or carrying an item listed in
- 24 subsection (1) in the line of duty.
- 25 (d) A member of the national guard, armed forces reserves,
- 26 NATIONAL GUARD, UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESERVES, or other duly
- 27 authorized military organization while on duty or drill or while

- 1 possessing or carrying an item listed in subsection (1) for
- 2 purposes of that military organization.
- 3 (e) Security personnel employed to enforce federal regulations
- 4 for access to a sterile area.
- (f) A court officer while engaged in his or her duties as a
- 6 court officer as authorized by a court.
- 7 (g) An airline or airport employee as authorized by his or her
- 8 employer.
- 9 (5) This section does not prohibit the individual from being
- 10 charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of
- 11 law committed by that individual while violating this section.
- 12 (6) A term of imprisonment imposed under this section may be
- 13 served consecutively to any other term of imprisonment imposed for
- 14 a violation of law arising out of the same transaction.
- 15 (7) As used in this section:
- 16 (a) "Commercial airport" means an airport that has regularly
- 17 scheduled commercial flights to and from other destinations.
- 18 (b) "Felony" means that term as defined in section 1 of
- 19 chapter I of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175, MCL
- 20 761.1, or a violation of a law of the United States that is
- 21 designated as a felony or that is punishable by death or by
- 22 imprisonment for more than 1 year.
- 23 (c) "Sterile area" means that term as defined in 14 C.F.R.
- 24 107.1.A PORTION OF AN AIRPORT THAT PROVIDES PASSENGERS ACCESS TO
- 25 BOARDING AIRCRAFT AND TO WHICH THAT ACCESS GENERALLY IS CONTROLLED
- 26 BY THE TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES
- 27 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, OR BY AN AIRCRAFT OPERATOR OR

- 1 FOREIGN AIR CARRIER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SECURITY MEASURES
- 2 ADOPTED BY THAT AIRCRAFT OPERATOR OR FOREIGN AIR CARRIER, THROUGH
- 3 THE SCREENING OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
